**STARSKATE EVENT REQUIREMENTS AND SPECIFICATIONS:** Please refer to the 2024-2025 Skate Canada STARSkate and Adult Technical Requirements guides, posted on the technical page of the BC/YT Section Website (skatinginbc.com).

**PAYMENTS**: All payment must be made online at the time of registration. Online registration must be completed by 11:45 pm on Friday October 25, 2024

**REFUNDS:** Entry fees will be refunded only if the competition is not held or if the entry is withdrawn before the closing date of entry. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN AFTER THE CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES (Friday October 25, 2024).

**CHANGES AND CORRECTIONS:** 48 hours following the closing of online registration, a list of all registrants will be posted on the <u>Gold Nugget competition page</u> of the BCYT Section website and the <u>Arctic Edge Skating Club</u> website and emailed to club members and coaches. Registrants then have 48 hours to notify the registrar of any changes or corrections.

**AGE CATEGORIES:** For all categories, age shall be the age of the skater before July 1, 2024 and assessments passed shall be as of October 25, 2024 (closing date of entries). Please note that age categories may be combined if there are insufficient entries in an individual category.

**PLANNED PROGRAM SHEETS**: Planned Program sheets must be submitted for all Freeskate and Artistic events for STAR 5-Gold and Special Olympics Singles. No Planned Program sheets are required for STAR 1-, Adult Artistic or Supplementary events. The deadline for submission of Planned Program Sheets is Friday November 15, 2024. **SCHEDULE**: A tentative schedule of events and groups will be posted on the events/competition pages of the <u>Arctic Edge Skating Club</u> and <u>BC/YT Section</u> websites. Any last-minute changes to the schedule will be posted on both websites and at the arena. Please note that events may start up to one half hour earlier than scheduled.

#### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- 1. **BC/YT SAFESPORT POLICY**: Phone, video, and/or mobile devices must be turned off and put away in bags while in dressing rooms. Parents and coaches are not permitted in dressing rooms; a family area will be provided for skaters who require assistance.
- 2. REGISTRATION ON DAY OF EVENT: Skaters must register at least 45 minutes before their event is scheduled to start. Please note that events may start up to 30 minutes earlier than scheduled.
- 3. SIZE of WARM-UP GROUPS: The maximum number of skaters on warm-up for all STAR categories except STAR 1 will be 8.
- 4. SCHEDULING: Depending on scheduling, skaters should be prepared to skate two programs on the same day.

5. All genders will compete together in all STAR Events except free skating.

- 7. ADMISSION will be free to all.
- 8. AWARDS will be presented at lunch time for the morning events and at the end of the day for the afternoon events.
- 9. MUSIC REQUIREMENTS: Music files for program events will be taken from Arctic Edge Skating Club's existing repertoire list found on the club's IPAD or provided by the coach/skater by emailing the club an updated file. Out of town skaters must submit their music in MP3 format by emailing <u>arcticedgesc@gmail.com</u> on or before November 15, 2024. A backup USB Flash drive for Arctic Edge Club members and non-members must be at the boards with the coach when the skater is competing. Alternate electronic items such as iPhones, tablets, MP3 players etc. will not be accepted.
- 10. PHOTOGRAPHER: There may be a photographer at this competition for official and action shots. Persons wishing to take photographs of on ice performances are reminded that use of flash cameras is forbidden. The use of video cameras must be restricted to areas that do not hamper the skaters or officials. **PLEASE NOTE:** you may only take pictures or videos of your own skater.
- 11. PROTESTS: Skate Canada Protest Rule will be followed. In addition, if there is an event using manual calculation where the results are not posted within one hour of the completion of the last event of the day, the protest must be made to the Event Referee within the first hour of the following day's competition. If the event Referee is unavailable, the protest may be made to the Technical Representative.
