Online registration must be completed by 11:45 PM Saturday, October 19, 2024

Entry in this competition is limited by the ice time available and priority will be given to Okanagan Region skaters. If there is insufficient ice time due to a large number of registrations, Individual and/or Group Showcase 1 & 2 and/or Creative events may be eliminated. In this case all registrants will be informed by Nov. 1, 2024 and their registration fee will be refunded.

**NOTE:** 48 hours following the closure of online registration, a list of all registrants will be posted on the Okanagan Region website and the Okanagan Interclub competition page of Skating in BC website. Everyone then has 48 hours to notify the Registrar of any changes. Beyond this time period, no changes will be permitted. This is to facilitate a faster turn-around time for the competition schedule to be published and for the Tech Rep to organize officials for the competition.

Requirements for Elements, Showcase and Creative Improv events can be found in the STAR Program Requirements Guide.

**Elements** – If there are not enough entries in Elements Star 6 and up, Elements Open will be added. Skaters will be informed and given the option to compete in Elements Open.

\*Synchronized Skating Events: Registration fees are \$150.00 per team and \$25 per skater. However, to assist with development of this discipline in the Okanagan Region, the per skater fees will be waived for the 2024 Interclub Competition.

Adult category specifications and age will follow the 2024-2025 Adult Program Requirements Guide

## An additional \$10.00 per entry has been included to offset the costs of live streaming.

Entry fees shall be refunded only if the competition is not held or if the request to withdraw is received before the closing date of entry. No refunds will be given after the close of entries (October 18, 2024) for any reason.

# LATE ENTRIES MAY BE ACCEPTED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE LOC AND TECH REP AND WILL BE CHARGED DOUBLE THE ENTRY FEE.

<u>Online Registration</u> must be completed by 11:45 p.m. Saturday, October 19, 2024. Instructions for entering online can be found on page 7 of this announcement.

For all categories age shall be the age of the skater before July 1, 2024, and tests passed shall be as of October 19, 2024 (closing date of entries). Age categories may be combined if there are insufficient entries in an individual category.

**INFO FOR PLANNED PROGRAM SHEETS: STAR 5-Gold Free Skate, Artistic, Adult Free Skate, and Podium Pathway entries** must submit a completed Planned Program sheet as part of their registration. Artistic planned programs must also indicate the start time of each element. No planned program is required for Adult Artistic.

Please be sure to complete the form as part of the registration. The registration cannot be submitted for any of the events listed above if the PPS is not completed.

A tentative schedule of events and groups will be posted on the <u>2024 Okanagan Interclub Competition</u> page of the Skating in BC website and on the <u>Okanagan Region website</u>. Any last-minute changes to schedules will be posted on the websites and at the arena. **Please note that events may start up to one half hour earlier than scheduled.** 

#### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

**BC/YT SAFESPORT POLICY**: Phone, video, and/or mobile devices must be turned off and put away in bags while in dressing rooms. Parents and coaches are not permitted in dressing rooms; a family area will be provided for skaters who require assistance.

- Skaters may enter only one event per discipline of singles and Artistic. If short and free programs are
  listed as separate events, skaters may enter one short program and one free program. Depending on
  scheduling, skaters should be prepared to skate two programs on the same day. Skaters choosing to
  enter more than one event do so with the understanding that there may be scheduling conflicts that
  are unable to be resolved.
- 2. All categories: Should entries in an event be exceedingly large, the event will be divided into smaller groups. Each group will be considered a final.
- 3. All genders will compete together in all STAR Events except free skating.
- 4. If an event has only one competitor or there is a last-minute withdrawal in an event that only had 2 entries, the skater will be informed and have the option of skating up an event, skating for an evaluation only, or withdrawing with a refund. Skating for evaluation is only applicable to Podium Pathway and STAR Free Skate categories. Medals will be awarded according to the 'Benchmark Scores' (for STARSkate only). If a technical panel is not available, the evaluation will be for Program Components only. Competitors may skate up one category higher than they are qualified for.
- 5. REGISTRATION: Skaters must register/check-in at least one hour before they are scheduled to skate. Please note that events may start up to 30 minutes earlier than scheduled.
- 6. SIZE of WARM-UP GROUPS: The maximum number of skaters on warm-up for all STAR categories except STAR 1, will be 8.

#### 8. MUSIC REQUIREMENTS:

- ALL SKATERS except for STAR 1 Free Skate, STAR 3 Synchro, Creative, and Elements must submit music online when they register.
  - Music will only be accepted electronically via MP3 format. Do not begin the registration process until you have your music file correctly marked and ready to load.
  - All MP3 files to be uploaded and must include the Skater's first name, last name, and the event the music is for in the file name. e.g. Sally Smith – Star 5 U13.mp3. If the event is age specific that must also be included as in example above. Without all of this information it is impossible for us to ensure the music links to the correct event.
- Music files are **NOT** kept for the next competition. Skaters must submit their music for each individual competition.
- A backup USB flash drive (<u>CDs will not be accepted</u>) must be at the boards with the coach
  when the skater is competing. The backup USB flash drives will no longer need to be turnedin or picked-up at registration.
- No alternate electronic items such as CDs, iPhones, tablets, MP3 players etc. will be accepted.
- 9. COACHES: To be at ice level during the events, it is mandatory for all participating coaches to be wearing their 2024/2025 BC/YT Section Coach Card Accreditation and register in person at the competition. These Coach Card Accreditations can be purchased through the BC/YT Section Office and must be purchased at least 2 weeks prior to the competition. Temporary accreditation will be issued for \$25 per day by showing current Skate Canada membership and First Aid information.
  2 Coaches per skater/team will be permitted at the boards for competition and warm up.
- 10. ADMISSION will be free to all.
- 11. AWARDS will be presented as soon as possible following the posting of results for each category.
- 12. Persons wishing to take photographs of on ice performances are reminded that use of flash cameras is forbidden. The use of video cameras must be restricted to areas that do not hamper the skaters or officials. **PLEASE NOTE:** you may only take pictures or videos of your own skater.
- 13. Protests: Skate Canada Protest Rule will be followed. In addition, if there is an event using manual calculation where the results are not posted within one hour of the completion of the last event of the day, the protest must be made to the Event Referee within the first hour of the following day's competition. If the Event Referee is unavailable, the protest may be made to the Technical Representative.
- 14. ASSESSMENTS: STAR Assessments will not be offered at this competition.

<sup>\*</sup> At the discretion of the Referee, the warm-up periods may be reduced to a minimum of 3 minutes. All warm-up periods for one event must be equal.

# **Online Registration Instructions**

**Okanagan Region has an online registration system with the company Karelo.com.** All registrations must be completed using this online system. **To begin the process please visit the site listed below:** 

# **LINK TO ONLINE REGISTRATION**

The registration system will generate an automatic email to the skater's coach. Coaches are encouraged to check the confirmation email to ensure their skater(s) is registered in the correct event.

## Using Karelo for the first time

The first time you use Karelo.com to register for an event, you will be asked to choose a <u>log in name & a password</u>, and to enter your contact information. When entering contact information, please use the skater's name and not the parent's name. Skate Canada Number must be entered as per your Skate Canada Card (ie. 10 digits including all zeros). This is a very short and simple step that will enable you to avoid the hassle of re-entering your information for each event registration! Your contact information is never shared with third parties. Please review Karelo's <u>'Privacy Policy'</u> for more details.

### **Entering your registration**

If you have never used Karelo.com before, go to '<u>I am new to Karelo.com</u>' and select a login name and a password; enter your contact information. Then follow these steps:

- 1. Log in. Select the event that you want to register for from the Event list.
- 2. Enter your registration information.
- 3. Enter your credit card information (Visa or MasterCard). This is a secure transaction. Your credit card is charged immediately.
- 4. You are registered! Check your email for the confirmation email with your registration details.

IMPORTANT: If you and your coach DO NOT receive an email confirmation from Karelo.com or receive a confirmation number, then you are NOT REGISTERED for the competition.
