# LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CHIEF REFEREE AND THE CHIEF DATA SPECIALIST AND WILL BE CHARGED DOUBLE THE ENTRY FEE.

Online registration must be completed by 11:45 p.m., Friday, January 4, 2013. Instructions for entering online can be found on page 8 of this announcement.

For all categories, age shall be the age of the skater before July 1, 2012 and tests passed shall be as of January 4, 2013 (closing date of entries). **Age categories may be combined if there are insufficient entries in an individual category.** 

Skaters who entered the BC/YT Section Championships in the Pre-Novice singles category may enter STARSkate events in Interclub competitions. However, they will not receive points for placement in the STARSkate standings. Skaters who competed in Novice or higher competitions are not eligible to enter any STARSkate freeskate events.

Competitors may skate up one category higher than they are qualified.



For event requirements and specifications, please refer to the 2012-2013 BC/YT Technical Packages posted on the Technical page of the <a href="Skating in B.C. website">Skating in B.C. website</a>. Please see page 7 for the Pre-Preliminary Dance criteria.

**PLANNED PROGRAM SHEETS** for all Free Skate events except STAR 1, 2 & 3 must be completed separately and e-mailed to Kathy Wallace, <u>wallacek25@gmail.com</u> no later than January 4, 2013 (closing date of entries).

A tentative schedule of events will be e-mailed to each club with confirmation of entry. There will be an official bulletin board at the arena listing the starting time of all events. This schedule will supersede all other schedules. The posting of notices on this board will be considered sufficient notification. **Please note that events may start up to one half hour earlier than scheduled.** 

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- 1. Previous winners of a Pre-Preliminary event at the 2012 Lynn Hetherington Memorial Competition must enter STAR 3 or higher. There are no restrictions for other categories that a skater may have won previously.
- 2. Skaters may enter only one event per discipline of single, pairs, dance and interpretive. The Local Organizing Committee event may also be entered as an additional event. Skaters choosing to enter more than one event do so with the understanding that there may be scheduling conflicts that are unable to be resolved.
- 3. All categories: Should entries in an event be exceeding large, the event will be divided into smaller groups. Each group will be considered a final.
- The skating order shall be drawn by lot and may be drawn by computer for the initial round for the first or only portion of an event. Except as noted, draws will be made in accordance with Skate Canada Rules.
- 5. Should there be only one entry in any event, the competitor **may** choose to be evaluated by one judge, skate up one level or withdraw and the entry fee will be refunded. If there is a last minute withdrawal in an event that had only 2 entries, the same options apply for the remaining skater. For the Local Organizing Committee event, there is only the option of skating up or withdrawing with a refund. No evaluation will be done for this type of event.
- 6. Note that in BC/YT Section competitions, men and women will compete together in Interpretive, Solo Dance and Elements events.
- 7. **COSTUMING:** The clothing for all competitors must be modest, dignified and appropriate for athletic competition not garish or theatrical in design. Props are not permitted.
- 8. **MARKING:** CPC will be used for all categories except Special Olympics and Pre-Preliminary Dance. STAR 1, 2 & 3 are assessed and skaters will receive a ribbon and an evaluation corresponding to their achievement..
- 9. **REGISTRATION:** Skaters must register at least one hour before their event is scheduled to start.
- 10. PRACTICE ICE: NO OFFICIAL ICE



11. **TEAM TROPHY:** Victoria Figure Skating Club Team Trophy awarded to the club with the highest total points. Points awarded from the competition results sheets:

4 or more in event: First - 5 Second - 3 Second - 3 Second - 1 Second - 3 Second - 1

#### 12. WARM UP TIMES WILL BE AS FOLLOWS:

All dance events will be governed by Skate Canada Rules.

The duration of the warm up periods may be reduced at the discretion of the referee to a minimum of three minutes. All warm up periods for one event must be equal.

- 13. **COACHES:** It is mandatoryfor all participating coaches to register at competitions and show their accreditation at all times during the competition in order to be at ice level during the events. Temporary accreditation will be issued by showing current Skate Canada membership and First Aid information for \$25.00 per day (payable to the V.I. Region Coaches Committee).
- 14. The host club will rope off an area at ice level for the accredited coaches.

#### 15. MUSIC REQUIREMENTS:

- Only CD's will be accepted. Only one program shall be recorded on each CD.
- The start of the music shall be recorded on the CD with less than two seconds of lead in.
- Competitor's name followed by music time (not skating time) shall be clearly printed on one side of the CD.
- Each CD shall be enclosed in its plastic container, also marked with the skater's name, home club, event and total music time.
- Competitors must hand in their music at the registration desk at least one hour prior to the start of their event. The Organizing Committee will accept no responsibility against damage but will take every precaution to safeguard each CD.
- A backup CD is a requirement of each competitor and should be at rinkside during the skater's performance.
- 16. Admission by donation.
- 17. **AWARDS:** Presentation of awards shall be as posted in the arena lobby. Medals will be presented to First, Second and Third place finishers in final events. Medallions will be presented to Fourth, Fifth and Sixth place finishers in Special Olympic events.
- 18. Persons wishing to take photographs of on ice performances are reminded that use of flash cameras is forbidden. The use of video cameras must be restricted to areas that do not hamper the skaters or the judges. **PLEASE NOTE:** you may only take pictures or videos of your own skater.



- 19. **PROTEST POLICY:** Skate Canada Protest Policy for competitions using CPC will be followed. RULE 7301 (6) (4). In addition, if there is an event using manual calculation where the results are not posted within one hour of the completion of the last event of the day, the protest must be made to the Event Referee within the first hour of the following day's competition. If the Event Referee is unavailable, the protest may be made to the Technical Representative or Chief Referee.
- 20. Tests are being held at this competition. Please see the attached Test Application Form.
- 21. <u>Parents are not allowed in restricted areas and dressing rooms.</u> The competition host club committee should provide a 'common area' where parents can be with their skaters before they compete.

## \*\*\* ONLINE REGISTRATION\*\*\*

All Vancouver Island Region Championships registrations must be done online Closing date of entries is Friday, January 4, 2013.

The registration system will generate an automatic e-mail to the skater's coach. Coaches are encouraged to check the confirmation e-mail to ensure their skater(s) is registered in the correct event.

If you are registering a skater in STAR 2 you also need to choose a music selection from the drop down menu.

For pair and couple dance events, both competitors must complete separate registrations online.

#### Using Karelo for the first time.

The first time you use Karelo.com to register for an event, you will be asked to choose a login name and a password and to enter your contact information. When entering contact information, please use the skater's name and not the parent's name. Skate Canada number must be entered as per your Skate Canada card (i.e. 10 digits including all zeros). This is a very short and simple step that will enable you to avoid the hassle of re-entering your information for each event registration. Your contact information is never shared with third parties. Please review Karelo's "Privacy Policy" for more details.

Credit card and debit payments can be made online. Cheque or money order payments must be sent to the competition Registrar but skaters must still register online. Payments must reach the Registrar by Friday, January 11, 2013 or the entry will be CANCELLED. Re-Registration will be double the entry fee. Send payments to:
