Entry fees shall be refunded only if the competition is not held or if the entry is withdrawn before the closing date of entry. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN AFTER THE CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES OF THE COMPETITION (March 2, 2016) FOR ANY REASON WHATSOEVER - SC RULE 7000 A 1.5(2).

LATE ENTRIES WILL BE CHARGED DOUBLE THE ENTRY FEE. All payments must be made online at the time of registration.

NOTE: All single event entries will be contacted the next business day following the close of entries. Single event entries must contact the BC/YK Section office within three business days to indicate whether they wish to withdraw, skate for evaluation or change categories (if applicable), otherwise the event will be cancelled with refund. (see General Information #3).

[Online Registration](#) must be completed by 11:45 p.m. Wednesday, March 2nd, 2016. Instructions for entering online can be found on page 7 of this announcement.

For all categories age shall be the age of the skater before July 1, 2015 and tests passed shall be as of March 2nd, 2016 (closing date of entries). **Please note that age categories may be combined if there are insufficient entries in an individual category.**

PLANNED PROGRAM SHEETS FOR ALL FREE SKATE EVENTS EXCEPT STAR 1,2,3 & 4 MUST BE SUBMITTED ONLINE ON THE [COAST REGISTRY](http://www.coastregistry.com) WEBSITE. Deadline to submit changes to planned program sheets is Wednesday, March 30th, 2016.

NOTE: There will be a \$20 fee assessed for failing to register planned program elements online by the March 30th deadline. Skaters will not be permitted to register at the competition until this fee has been paid and a planned program sheet has been completed.

A tentative schedule of events and groups will be posted on the [Super Series Vancouver Island](#) competition page on the Skating in BC website. Any last minute changes to schedules will be posted on the website and also at the arena. **Please note that events may start up to one half hour earlier than scheduled.**

Starting orders will be posted a minimum of 24 hours prior to the start of the competition.

TESTS: STARSkate Free Skate Part Two tests, Senior Bronze to Gold and Interpretive will be offered. Skaters must be registered to compete in the same event they are testing in. The exception is skaters competing in a competitive category who may also apply for Junior Silver, Senior Silver or Gold Free Skate Part Two. In this case, if the test is passed, the skater will receive credit for both Parts 1 and 2 of the test. As such, skaters will need to pay for both parts when registering, regardless of the outcome of the test. If a skater has already passed Part 1, they will not need to pay again. Deadline to receive test applications is Friday, March 25th, 2016. Refer to the Test Application form on the [competition page](#) for further information.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Skaters may enter only one event per discipline of singles, pairs, dance and interpretive. Junior and Senior Singles - points will only count for Super Series standings if you enter both the short and free program.
2. Should entries in a category be exceedingly large, the event will be divided into smaller groups, which will be determined by random draw. STAR 1-3 groups will be divided according to age. Interpretive events will be divided by free skate test level first and then if further grouping is required, by age. Age categories may be combined when there are less than 6 entries in a category.
3. If an event has only one competitor, the skater will be informed and have the option of skating up an event, skating for an evaluation only, or withdrawing with a refund. When skating for an evaluation, feedback may be in the form of judges' comments only, if a technical panel is not available to assess technical content. Competitors may skate up one category higher than they are qualified.

4. MARKING: STAR 1,2, 3 & 4 and Pre-Introductory & Introductory Interpretive categories are assessed. Skaters in STAR 1, 2 & 3 & the two Interpretive categories will receive a ribbon and a report card corresponding to their achievement. STAR 4 skaters will be ranked and skaters placing 1st, 2nd and 3rd will receive medals. All skaters in STAR 4 will receive a report card showing individual element assessments. Special O categories will be assessed and ranked with the exception of Level 6 & Open Singles and Levels 1-6 Dance, which will be marked in CPC. All other categories will be marked using the CPC Scoring system.

5. REGISTRATION:

Skaters must register at least one hour before their event is scheduled to start.

6. WARM UP TIMES:

Dance events will be conducted in accordance with Skate Canada regulations.

* At the discretion of the Referee, the warm up periods may be reduced to a minimum of 3 minutes. All warm-up periods for one event must be equal.

7. MUSIC REQUIREMENTS:

- **Music will be accepted electronically via MP3 format or submitted on CD at the competition. Please refer to the [Super Series Vancouver Island](#) competition page for information on submitting music electronically.**
- **A backup CD is a requirement of each competitor and should be at rinkside during the skater's performance.**
- Only CD's will be accepted. Only one program shall be recorded on each CD.
- The start of the music shall be recorded on the CD with less than two seconds of lead in.
- Competitor's name followed by music time (not skating time) shall be clearly printed on one side of the CD.
- Each CD shall be enclosed in its plastic container, also marked with the skater's name, home club, event and total music time.
- Competitors must hand in their music at the registration desk at least one hour prior to the start of their event. The Organizing Committee will accept no responsibility against damage but will take every precaution to safeguard each CD.
- **Solo Dance competitors who choose to use Skate Canada Contemporary Dance Music must provide this music on an individual CD when they register onsite at the competition.**

8. ICE SURFACE: 80' x 200'

9. COACHES: It is mandatory for all participating coaches to register at competitions and show their accreditation at all times during the competition in order to be at ice level during the events. Temporary accreditation will be issued for \$25.00 by showing current Skate Canada membership and First Aid information. **NOTE: NO MORE THAN TWO COACHES PER SKATER WILL BE PERMITTED AT THE BOARDS FOR WARM-UP AND COMPETITION**
10. ADMISSION will be free to all.
11. AWARDS: A notice will be posted in the arena with information regarding the time and location of medal presentations.
12. Persons wishing to take photographs of on ice performances are reminded that use of flash cameras is forbidden. The use of video cameras must be restricted to areas that do not hamper the skaters or officials. **PLEASE NOTE:** you may only take pictures or videos of your own skater.
13. Protest Policy: Skate Canada Protest Policy for competitions using CPC will be followed. RULE 7301 (6) (4). In addition, if there is an event using manual calculation where the results are not posted within one hour of the completion of the last event of the day, the protest must be made to the Event Referee within the first hour of the following day's competition. If the Event Referee is unavailable, the protest may be made to the Technical Representative.

BC/YK SECTION Online Registration Instructions

Skate Canada-BC/YK Section uses an online registration system with the company Wufoo.com. All registrations must be completed using this online system. [Click here](#) to register.

The registration system will generate an automatic email to the skater and the primary coach. Coaches are encouraged to check the confirmation email to ensure their skater(s) is registered in the correct event.

There is no login required to fill out the Wufoo Competition form. Skaters enter their information in all the required fields and then click "Submit". After clicking the submit button skaters will be taken to PayPal to pay their competition registration fee. All skaters must pay their competition entry fee through PayPal. Please note that it is not necessary to have a PayPal account to complete the registration process.

If skaters are unsure of what to enter in the various entry form fields, please contact your coach.
