Entry fees shall be refunded only if the competition is not held or if the entry is withdrawn before the closing date of entry. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN AFTER THE CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES OF THE COMPETITION (September 13th, 2017) FOR ANY REASON WHATSOEVER

Single Entries: All single event entries will be contacted the next business day following the close of entries. Single event entries must contact the BC/YK Section office within three business days to indicate whether they wish to withdraw, skate for evaluation or change categories (if applicable), otherwise the event will be cancelled with refund. Skating for an evaluation is only applicable to competitive categories and STAR Free Skating categories. If a technical panel is not available the evaluation will be for Program Components only.

All payments must be made online at the time of registration.

LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE COMPETITION COMMITTEE AND WILL BE CHARGED DOUBLE THE ENTRY FEE.

<u>Online Registration</u> must be completed by 11:45 p.m. Wednesday, September 13th, 2017. Instructions for entering online can be found on page 7 of this announcement.

For all categories age shall be the age of the skater before July 1st, 2017; tests passed shall be as of September 13th, 2017 (closing date of entries). **Age categories may be combined if there are insufficient entries in an individual category.**

PLANNED PROGRAM SHEETS FOR ALL FREE SKATE EVENTS EXCEPT STAR 1,2,3 & 4 MUST BE SUBMITTED ONLINE BY WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 11TH, 2017. Click here to enter planned program information.

Note: there will be a \$20 fee assessed for failing to register planned program elements online by the October 11th deadline. Skaters will not be permitted to register at the competition until this fee has been paid and a planned program sheet has been completed.

A tentative schedule of events and groups will be posted on the <u>Autumn Leaves competition page</u> of the BC/YK Section website. Any last minute changes to schedules will be posted on the website and also at the arena. Please note that events may start up to one half hour earlier than scheduled.

Starting orders will be posted a minimum of 24 hours prior to the start of the competition.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Skaters may enter only one event per discipline of singles, pairs or dance. If short and free
 programs are listed as separate events, then one short and one free program category may be
 entered.
- 2. Pre-Juvenile Singles category music time for BC/YK competitions may be either 2:00 minutes (+/- 10 seconds) or 2:30 minutes (+/- 10 seconds)
- 3. Skaters entering dance categories, the pattern dance draws will be the dances that are posted for Sectionals.
- 4. Skaters entering multiple disciplines should be aware that there may be scheduling conflicts resulting in less than ideal scheduling, or that are unable to be resolved
- 5. All categories: Should entries in an event be exceedingly large, the event will be divided into smaller groups. Each group will be considered a final. Age categories may be combined if there are insufficient entries in a category.
- 6. If an event has only one competitor, the skater will be informed and have the option of skating up an event, skating for an evaluation only, or withdrawing with a refund. When skating for an evaluation, if a technical panel is not available to assess technical content, feedback may be in the form of judges' comments only. Skating for an evaluation is only applicable to STAR Free Skate and all competitive categories. Competitors may skate up one category higher than they are qualified.
- 7. MARKING: STAR 1,2, 3 & 4 categories are assessed. Skaters in STAR 1, 2 & 3 will receive a ribbon and a report card corresponding to their achievement. STAR 4 skaters will be ranked and skaters placing 1st, 2nd and 3rd will receive medals. All skaters in STAR 4 will receive a report card showing individual element assessments. All other categories will be marked using the CPC Scoring system.
- 8. REGISTRATION:

Skaters must register at least one hour before their event is scheduled to start.

9. WARM UP TIMES:

STAR 2 3 minutes
STAR 3, 4 & 5 4 minutes
STAR 6 to Gold Free Skate 5 minutes
Pre-Juvenile 5 minutes
Juvenile to Senior Competitive 6 minutes
Pattern Dance & Solo Short Dance 4 minutes
Short/Free Dance 5 minutes

^{*} At the discretion of the Referee, the warm up periods may be reduced to a minimum of 3 minutes. All warm-up periods for one event must be equal.

10. MUSIC REQUIREMENTS:

- ALL SKATERS with the exception of STAR 1 must submit music online as part of the registration process.
- Music will now only be accepted electronically via MP3 format. Do not begin the
 registration process until you have your music file ready to load. Questions can be directed

- Music files are not kept for the next competition. Skaters must submit their music for each individual competition.
- Competitors must hand in their back up file either USB flash drive or CD at the
 registration desk at least one hour prior to the start of their event. The Organizing
 Committee will accept no responsibility against damage but will take every precaution to
 safeguard each USB/CD.
- A backup USB flash drive or CD must be submitted at registration.
- Alternate electronic items such as iPhones, tablets, mp3 players etc. will not be accepted for playing music.
- The preferred backup format is a USB flash drive. If submitting a backup CD, the following requirements must be met:
 - Only one program shall be recorded on each CD.
 - > The start of the music shall be recorded on the CD with less than two seconds of lead in.
 - Competitor's name followed by music time (not skating time) shall be clearly printed on one side of the CD.
 - Each CD shall be enclosed in its plastic container, also marked with the skater's name, home club, event, and total music time.
- 11. COACHES: It is mandatory for all participating coaches to register at competitions and show their accreditation at all times during the competition in order to be at ice level during the events. Temporary accreditation will be issued for \$25.00 by showing current Skate Canada membership and First Aid information.
- 12. ADMISSION will be free to all.
- 13. AWARDS will be presented immediately following the posting of results for each category.
- 14. Persons wishing to take photographs of on ice performances are reminded that use of flash cameras is forbidden. The use of video cameras must be restricted to areas that do not hamper the skaters or officials. **PLEASE NOTE:** you may only take pictures or videos of your own skater.
- 15. Protest Policy: Skate Canada Protest Policy for competitions using CPC will be followed. In addition, if there is an event using manual calculation where the results are not posted within one hour of the completion of the last event of the day, the protest must be made to the Event Referee within the first hour of the following day's competition. If the Event Referee is unavailable, the protest may be made to the Technical Representative or Chief Referee.

BC/YK SECTION Online Registration Instructions

Skate Canada-BC/YK Section's online registration is with the company Wufoo.com. All registrations must be completed using this online system.

<u>Click here</u> to register.

The registration system will generate an automatic email to the skater and the primary coach. Coaches are encouraged to check the confirmation email to ensure their skater(s) is registered in the correct event.

There is no login required to fill out the Wufoo Competition form. Skaters enter their information in all the required fields and then click "Submit". After clicking the submit button skaters will be taken to PayPal to pay their competition registration fee. All skaters must pay their competition entry fee through PayPal. Please note that it is not necessary to have a PayPal account to complete the registration process.

If skaters are unsure of what to enter in the various entry form fields, please contact your coach.
