The BC/YK Section is hosting its Third Annual Music and announcer Training on Wednesday August 14th 6:30-9 p.m. in Burnaby. If you have ever hosted a test day or competition, you know how critical it is to have trained volunteers running your equipment. The training will be held in the Burnaby Lake Field House a 2 minute walk north of the 8-rinks / Centre of Excellence facility.

Topics include:

- What the job entails
- Tips and tricks of doing a great job
- How to prepare before stepping onto the stand
- Why timing is important
- What to do in an emergency as an announcer or music player
- Using a script for announcing (New Star Scripts will be reviewed)
- Operating the music equipment
- Screen shots of the announcer module from the computer system will be reviewed

At the conclusion of this training, you will be capable of volunteering as a music player or an announcer at any Regional Competition. Additionally, as a result of this training you will be invited to do a shift at the BC/YK SummerSkate Competition Thursday August 15th through 18th, 2013.

Other opportunities may arise as a result of participating in this training such as being selected for other Section level assignments or participating in Live Streaming Production.
