**YOUR ENTRY FEE MUST ACCOMPANY THE ENTRY FORM.** Please make all cheques or money orders payable to the **NORTH STAR FIGURE SKATING CLUB** and forward to the Registrar with your entry form and Planned Program Sheet.

LATE ENTRIES MAY BE ACCEPTED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE LOC AND WILL BE CHARGED DOUBLE THE ENTRY FEE.

Entries will close at 11:45 pm, Tuesday, October 29<sup>th</sup>, 2013.

For all categories age shall be the age of the skater before July 1, 2013 and tests passed shall be as of October 29<sup>th</sup>, 2013 (closing date of entries). **Age categories may be combined if there are insufficient entries in an individual category.** 

For event requirements and specifications, please refer to the 2013-2014 BC/YK Technical Packages for STARSkate and Competitive, posted on the Technical page of the <u>Skating in BC website</u>. Solo Dances to be skated are also posted on the <u>Skating in BC website</u> (Officials & Judges Page/Technical Information/Dance Info) as are the requirements for the 5 levels of the Elements events.

**PLANNED PROGRAM SHEETS** for ALL Free Skate events except STAR 1, 2, 3 & 4 should be submitted to the registrar with the registration. Skaters arriving to compete who have not submitted a planned program sheet or have changes, <u>must</u> complete one when they register their music.

A tentative schedule of events and groups will be sent to your club via email. Any last minute changes to schedules will be posted on the websites and also at the arena. **Please note that events may start up to one half hour earlier than scheduled.** 

Starting orders will be posted at the arena prior to the start of the competition.

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- 1. Skaters may enter only one event per discipline.
- 2. All categories: Should entries in an event be exceedingly large, the event will be divided into smaller groups. Each group will be considered a final.
- 3. If an event has only one competitor, the skater will be informed and have the option of skating up an event or withdrawing with a refund. Competitors may skate up one category higher than they are qualified.
- MARKING: The CPC Scoring system will be used for all events with the exception of STAR 1, 2, 3 & 4. These categories are assessed. Skaters in STAR 1, 2 & 3 will receive a ribbon and a report card corresponding to their achievement. STAR 4 skaters will be ranked and skaters placing 1st, 2nd and 3rd will receive medals. All skaters in STAR 4 will receive a report card showing

individual element assessments

- 5. REGISTRATION: Skaters must register at least one hour before their event is scheduled to start.
- 6. WARM UP TIMES:

STAR 2	3 minutes
STAR 3 to Senior Bronze	4 minutes
Pre Juvenile, Junior Silver to Gold Free Skate	5 minutes
Juvenile	6 minutes
Interpretive	3 minutes

\* At the discretion of the Referee, the warm up periods may be reduced to a minimum of 3 minutes. All warm-up periods for one event must be equal.

#### 7. MUSIC REQUIREMENTS:

- Only CD's will be accepted. Only one program shall be recorded on each CD.
- The start of the music shall be recorded on the CD with less than two seconds of lead in.
- Competitor's name followed by music time (not skating time) shall be clearly printed on one side of the CD.
- Each CD shall be enclosed in its plastic container, also marked with the skater's name, home club, event and total music time.
- Competitors must hand in their music at the registration desk at least one hour prior to the start of their event. The Organizing Committee will accept no responsibility against damage but will take every precaution to safeguard each CD.
- A backup CD is a requirement of each competitor and should be at rinkside during the skater's performance.

# New: Skaters registering in STAR 2, 3 & 4 may choose their own choice of music or one of the Section provided music selections; however, all skaters <u>must</u> submit a CD of their music (even if using Section music selections). STAR 1 skaters are not required to submit a CD.

COACHES: It is mandatory for all participating coaches to register at competitions and show their accreditation at all times during the competition in order to be at ice level during the events. Temporary accreditation will be issued for \$25.00 by showing current Skate Canada membership and First Aid information.

- 8. ADMISSION will be free to all.
- AWARDS ceremonies, times and place, will be posted at the arena. All STAR 1, 2 and 3 skaters will receive ribbons and report cards corresponding to their final assessment. Medals for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place will be awarded in all other events.
- Protest Policy: Skate Canada Protest Policy for competitions using CPC will be followed. RULE 7301 (6)
  (4). In addition, if there is an event using manual calculation where the results are not posted within one hour of the completion of the last event of the day, the protest must be made to the Event Referee within the first hour of the following day's competition. If the Event Referee is unavailable, the protest may be made to the Technical Representative or Chief Referee.
