# \*\*\* ONLINE REGISTRATION \*\*\*

All SummerSkate registrations must be done <u>online</u>. Closing date of entries is July 13, 2011

Credit card payments can be made online. Cheque, cash, or money order payments must be sent to the BCYT Section office but skaters must still register online. Payments must reach the Section office by July 20<sup>th</sup>, 2011 or the entry will be CANCELLED. Re-Registration will be double the entry fee. Send payment to:

Skaters will receive a confirmation number when their registration is accepted. If no confirmation is received, the skater is not registered.

# 2011 BC/YT SUMMERSKATE Pond to Podium Super-Series Event

# Hosted by the BC /YT SECTION at Burnaby 8 Rinks AUGUST 18-21, 2011

BC SummerSkate is the third competition in the BC/YT Section Pond to Podium Super Series. Skaters entering Competitive Skate events and STARSkate Free Skate Junior Bronze to Gold will automatically have their scores input into a master standings display taking the top 25 scores for short program, free program and overall. These standings will then be posted on <a href="mailto:skatinginbc.com">skatinginbc.com</a> and as each competition in the series is completed the standings on the website will reflect any changes. A <a href="mailto:detailed description">detailed description</a> of the components of the Super Series is included with this announcement. #### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

Singles, pairs and dance events are open to registered skaters in good standing with Skate Canada and U.S. Figure Skating or any ISU affiliated club. The competition is sanctioned by Skate Canada and U.S. Figure Skating. It is organized and shall be conducted in accordance with the current Skate Canada Rulebook, except where modified in this announcement.

- a) Previous winners of a Pre-Preliminary event must move up. There are no restrictions for other categories that a skater may have won previously.
- b) STARSkate Categories: Should entries in any STARSkate event be exceedingly large, the event will be divided into smaller groups which will be divided by age. Each group will be considered a final.
- c) Competitive Categories: Each event will be a final with no division into groups. Two part events will be judged for a combined result...there will not be separate Short and Free Program event categories.
- d) Skaters may enter only one event per discipline of singles, pairs and dance.
- e) Performance Program will not be offered at this competition.
- f) MARKING

The CPC Scoring system will be used for all Competitive events and STARSkate Free Skate events from Junior Bronze to Gold.

**NEW**: We will be piloting a scoring system for STARSkate Pre-Preliminary and Preliminary Free Skate. Results will be calculated on a points system and skaters will receive a report card. g) Competitors may "skate-up" one category above their qualifications.

- h) NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN AFTER THE CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES (11:59 p.m. July 13, 2011) FOR ANY REASON WHATSOEVER. LATE ENTRIES WILL BE CHARGED DOUBLE THE ENTRY FEE. FOR THOSE PAYING BY CASH, CHEQUE OR MONEY ORDER, PAYMENT FOR ENTRY MUST BE RECEIVED IN THE SECTION OFFICE BY JULY 20<sup>th</sup>, 2011 OR THE ENTRY WILL BE CANCELLED.
- i) PRACTICE ICE: Practice Ice will be available for all skaters at \$15.00 for 30 minutes. A practice schedule will be posted on the Section website (<a href="www.skatinginbc.com">www.skatinginbc.com</a>). Practices can be booked by calling the BC/YT Section office during office hours 8:30 am 4:30 pm Monday to Friday (604) 205-6960 or toll free 1-888-752-8322; or forms can be down loaded off the website and faxed or mailed to the Section office with payment. Payment is required at the time of booking.
  - PLEASE NOTE: No music will be played on practice ice sessions.
- j) ATTENTION COACHES: It is mandatory for all participating coaches to register at competitions and show their accreditation at all times during the competition in order to be at ice level during the events. Temporary accreditation will be issued for \$25.00 by showing current Skate Canada membership and First Aid information.
- k) TESTS: Competitive tests will be offered in all disciplines. STARSkate Free Skate Part Two tests will be offered in categories Senior Bronze to Gold. Skaters must be registered to compete in the same event they are testing in. Test Applications should be completed online by going to the <a href="Coast Registry">Coast Registry</a> website. Deadline for applications is August 4, 2011. Should you have any questions about the test application process, please contact Margaret Warwick.

- I) TENTATIVE SCHEDULE OF EVENTS & GROUPS will be posted on the BC/YT Section website (<a href="www.skatinginbc.com">www.skatinginbc.com</a>). Any last minute changes to schedules will be posted on the website and also at the arena. Please note that events may start up to one half hour earlier than scheduled.
- m) STARTING ORDERS will be posted on the BC/YT Section website 24 hours prior to the start of the competition.

#### n) FEES:

#### **PLEASE NOTE:**

Included in these fees is the live streaming service of both rinks and every skater. We are also making each skaters program available for download on you tube so **there will not be any need to purchase a DVD**. As part of the Super Series competitions every skater will be able to download their programs as part of our upgraded service during this series. A release form is included as part of the Karelo online registration process.

Your entry fee must accompany the entry form. Please make all cheques or money orders payable to: "SKATE CANADA - BC/YT SUMMMERSKATE". No post-dated cheques past July 13<sup>th</sup>, 2011 will be accepted.

- o) ENTRIES must be in the hands of the registrar (BC/YT Section Office) by midnight July 13<sup>th</sup>, 2011. Eligibility for entries is governed by tests passed and/or age restriction as of July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011. If only one entry is received for an event, the entry fee will be refunded and the event cancelled.
- p) PLANNED PROGRAM SHEETS for ALL Competitive and STARSkate Free Skate events may be submitted online with skater entry information or sent to the BC/YT Section office via fax or mail.
- q) MUSIC: Only CD's will be accepted with only one program recorded on each CD. CDs must be marked with the competitor's name, home club, event, and total music time (not skating time); enclosed in their integral container and marked accordingly. Competitors must hand in their music at the registration desk at least one hour prior to the start of their event. The SummerSkate Committee will accept no responsibility against damage but will take every precaution to safeguard each CD. A backup CD is a requirement of each competitor and should be at rinkside during the skater's performance.
- r) ADMISSION will be free to all.
- s) AWARDS will be presented immediately following the posting of results for each category.
- t) **REGISTRATION**

Skaters must register at least one hour before their event is scheduled to start.

u) ARENA

The competition will be held at Burnaby Ice Sport Centre, 6501 Sprott St., Burnaby, BC. The ice surface is 85" x 200' with slightly rounded corners.

#### v) WARM UP TIMES

Pre-Preliminary 3 minutes
Preliminary to Senior Bronze 4 minutes
Junior Silver to Gold Free Skate 5 minutes
Pre-Juvenile 5 minutes
Juvenile to Senior Competitive 6 minutes

Dance warm-up times will be according to SC Regulations.

\* At the discretion of the Referee, the warm up periods may be reduced to a minimum of 3 minutes.

All warm-up periods for one event must be equal.

w) Protest Policy: Skate Canada Protest Policy for competitions using CPC will be followed. RULE 7301 (6) (4). In addition, if there is an event using manual calculation where the results are not posted within one hour of the completion of the last event of the day, the protest must be made to the Event Referee within the first hour of the following day's competition. If the Event Referee is unavailable, the protest may be made to the Technical Representative.
