GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. The Event is being held under the current rules of the Association Official Rulebook (revised 2000) and any amendments thereto which became effective after that date. The nature of the Event is defined in the Skate Canada Technical Handbook, 5000 Competitive Program. The Association reserves the right to alter the overall procedures to be followed during any part of the Event, if such alteration is considered to be in the best interest of the skaters or the Association. The Technical Representative, Chief Referee, or Senior Referee present will be the agent of the Association in such an instance.
- 2. **CATEORIES:** The following Categories are to be held:

For all categories the appropriate Skate Canada Well Balanced Program criteria shall be followed. Requirements for additional events being offered can be found further in this announcement (identified with a * below).

All interpretive and synchro events will be judged using the CPC marking system.

Team Events, Solo Dance, and Pro/Am Dance will be judged using the 6.0 OBO marking system.

All other events will be judged using the CPC marking system dependent on official availability. If officials are unavailable, events will be judged using the 6.0 OBO marking system, this will be communicated when the schedule is completed.

Where entries warrant, events will be broken down by age class as follows:

Adult Introductory 18-24 years
Class I 25-35 years
Class II 36-45 years
Class III 46-55 years
Class IV 56 years and over

- 5. **ENTRIES**: Entrants in Events shall be:
 - a) Eligible persons as defined in Skate Canada Rule Book Section 2100
 - b) Be Associate members in good standing of the Association.

Registration forms **must be completed in FULL** or they may not be processed!

Restriction of Entries – IF NECESSARY ENTRIES MUST BE LIMITED TO ADHERE TO THE SECTION GUIDELINES FOR HOURS OF COMPETITION – COMPETITION MAY NOT BEGIN BEFORE 12 PM ON FRIDAY AND MAY NOT RUN MORE THAN 12 HOURS ON SATURDAY. COMPETITION MUST BE COMPLETED BY 5 PM ON SUNDAY

Skaters registered to compete in any event at the Novice or higher level at Sectionals, do not qualify to compete in the FunSkate. Skaters registered to compete in the PreJuvenile to PreNovice level at Sectionals may register to compete in event categories listed in the chart in the Section Technical Package (page 4).

For skaters with competitive test but are not registered as competitive skaters in this competitive year, can refer the chart in the Section Technical Package for equivalency events (page 5).

- 6. CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES: All entries must be received no later than January 6, 2012. In the event of a postal disruption it is the responsibility of the competitor to ensure that their entry is in to the Host Committee Registration person by the closing date, at their own expense. ALL QUALIFYING TESTS MUST BE PASSED BY DECEMBER 16, 2011.
- 7. **LATE ENTRIES:** Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Tech Rep at double the entry fees until **January 13, 2012**.
- 8. MUSIC REGISTRATION: (Rule 5705).

Information regarding the requirements and standards for CDs are listed in the 2011 Alberta-NWT/Nunavut Section Technical Package as posted on the Section's website: www.skateabnwtnun.com

Competitors are responsible for the recovery of their own CDs at the completion of the Event.

9. **ACCIDENTS**: The Association and Committee of the Host Club undertake no responsibility for damages or injuries suffered by the skater. As a condition of and in consideration of their entries in these Championships, all competitors and their parents or guardians shall be deemed to agree to assume all risks or injuries to the competitor's person and property resulting from, or caused by, or connected with the conduct and management of the competitions. An agreement must also be deemed to release any and all claims they may have against the officials, the Association, the Host Club, and their officers. Entries shall be accepted only in accordance with these conditions.

10. **REFUND OF ENTRY FEES**:

Entry fees shall be refunded only if the event is not held or if the entry is withdrawn before the date of close of entries (Skate Canada Rule 7000 - 1.5 (2)).

11. **REGISTRATION**: Skaters must register at least one hour prior to their scheduled Category or practice. Music must be turned in at the time of registration. **(2 copies of music must be registered).** Skaters must report to the Ice Captain one hour prior to their scheduled Category.

Please refer to the Alberta-NWT/Nunavut Section Technical Package for further details regarding music requirements.

- 12. **FLIGHT SYSTEM:** If the number of competitors in a Category warrants it, a flight system will be used. Flights would be determined by skaters' ages. Please refer to the 2011 Alberta-NWT/Nunavut Section Technical Package as posted on the Section's website: www.skateabnwtnun.com for details.
- 13. **EVENT SPECIFICATIONS:** In normal circumstances, each category offered at the competition will be held for men and women separately. It is permissible for events that do not progress skaters on to a subsequent level of Interclub competition to combine events as follows:
 - (a) Combine two or more categories in the same event when each category has fewer than three entries;
 - (b) Combine two or more categories in the same event when one category has insufficient entries to hold the event;

(c) Combine men and women in events when insufficient entries are registered in one to hold the event.

The decision to combine events is at the discretion of the Technical Representative and the Host Committee. In any of the above cases, categories may be combined – only with full prior knowledge and agreement of all competitors affected. If a category is not held, due to a lack of competitors, the Host Committee will inform competitors and return entry fees.

14. **CANCELLATION OF EVENTS:** The host club reserves the right to cancel events.

15. **EVENT REGISTRATION & ELIGIBILITY:**

Refer to the 2011 Alberta-NWT/Nunavut Section Technical Package as posted on the Section's website: www.skateabnwtnun.com for details regarding skating up, technical requirements & entry/qualification restrictions.

- 16. **COACH ACCREDITATION**: All coaches must be minimally certified NCCP Level 1, Level 1 CanSkate Coach or Level 1 STARSkate Primary Coach and carry their Photo ID card indicating current membership within the Association and a valid First Aid certificate. A maximum of 5 Program Assistants may accompany a certified coach to assist with FunSkate competitions. Coaches may expect to register at the registration desk.
- 17. **WARM UP TIMES:** Skate Canada has standardized warm up times for all events. Refer to the 2011 Alberta-NWT/Nunavut Section Technical Package as posted on the Section's website: www.skateabnwtnun.com for all warm up times.

ADDITIONAL EVENT REQUIREMENTS

Introductory Freeskate: Must not have passed any portion of the Preliminary Freeskate test. One freeskate program to music of a maximum 2.0 minutes. Shorter program times will not be penalized. May include jumps up to loop and flip but no higher jump. Higher jumps, if attempted, will be given no credit. Maximum of 4 jump elements, 2 spin elements, and 1 step/spiral sequence.

<u>Couples Preliminary Dance:</u> Skaters may have passed the complete Preliminary Dance test but not the complete Jr Bronze Dance test.

SPECIFICATIONS FOR EVENT: Baby Blues (3 sequences) and Canasta Tango (3 sequences).

Pro/Am Dance: In this event the skaters will perform the **Rocker Foxtrot** with a Professional Dance Partner. The event will be judged like a test day in that the partner may skate with several adult skaters but only the candidate will be judged. There is no test level required.

Solo Dance

Pre-Preliminary:

- (i) TEST: Skaters must not have passed the complete Preliminary Dance test
- (ii) SPECIFICATIONS FOR EVENT: Baby Blues (3 sequences)

Preliminary:

- (i) TEST: Skaters must not have passed the complete Junior Bronze Dance test
- (ii) SPECIFICATIONS FOR EVENT: Swing (2 sequences)

Junior Bronze:

- (i) TEST: Skaters must not have passed the complete Senior Bronze Dance test
- (ii) SPECIFICATIONS FOR EVENT: European (2 sequences)

Senior Bronze:

- (i) TEST: Skaters must not have passed the complete Junior Silver Dance test
- (ii) SPECIFICATIONS FOR EVENT: Keats Foxtrot (4 sequences)

Junior Silver:

- (i) TEST: Skaters must not have passed the complete Senior Silver Dance test
- (ii) SPECIFICATIONS FOR EVENT: Blues (3 sequences)

Senior Silver:

- (i) TEST: Skaters must not have passed the complete Gold Dance test
- (ii) SPECIFICATIONS FOR EVENT: Silver Samba (2 sequences)

Gold:

- (i) TEST: Skaters must not have passed the complete Diamond Dance test
- (ii) SPECIFICATIONS FOR EVENT: Rhumba (4 sequences)

Team Events

Teams may consist of 3 or 4 skaters. Teams may choose which skater performs each element.

<u>Introductory:</u> Skaters must not have passed the complete Preliminary Freeskate test. Elements to be skated:

- 1. Waltz Jump
- 2. Toe Loop/Toe Loop Jump Combination
- 3. Forward One Foot Spin (No corkscrew or other variation permitted)
- 4. Forward Outside Spiral minimum 3 seconds (No variation of position permitted)

Bronze: Skaters may have passed the Preliminary Freeskate test but not the complete Junior Bronze Freeskate test. Elements to be skated:

- 1. Flip Jump
- 2. Loop/Loop Jump Combination
- 3. Sit Spin (No variation of position permitted)
- 4. Forward Inside Spiral minimum 3 seconds (Variation of position permitted)

<u>Silver:</u> Skaters may have passed the Junior Bronze Freeskate test but not the complete Senior Bronze Freeskate test. Elements to be skated:

- 1. Lutz Jump
- 2. Flip/Loop Jump Combination
- 3. Camel/Sit Spin minimum 2 rotations in each basic position (Additional rotations in variation permitted)
- 4. 2 spirals in sequence one on each foot, minimum 3 seconds each (Variation of position permitted)

Gold: Skaters may have passed the Senior Bronze Freeskate test but not the complete Junior Silver Freeskate test. Elements to be skated:

- 1. Axel Jump
- 2. Jump Combination consisting of 2 single jumps or 1 single and 1 double jump
- 3. Flying Camel Spin minimum 3 rotations in basic position (Additional rotations in variation permitted)
- 4. Spiral Sequence consisting of at least one spiral on each foot minimum 3 seconds each (Variation of position permitted)

<u>Masters:</u> Skaters may have passed the Junior Silver Freeskate test or higher but no Competitive Singles test. Elements to be skated:

- 1. Double Toe Jump
- 2. Jump Combination consisting of 1 single and 1 double jump or 2 double jumps (second jump must be a double)
- 3. Spin Combination with at least 2 positions and 1 change of foot minimum 3 rotations per position
- 4. Spiral Sequence with 3 positions held for minimum 3 seconds each with at least 1 change of foot

Competitive: Skaters may have passed any Competitive Singles test. Elements to be skated:

- 1. Double Loop Jump
- 2. Jump Combination consisting of at least 2 double jumps
- 3. Spin Combination with at least 3 positions and 1 change of foot minimum 3 rotations per position
- 4. Combination of 3 Field Movements in Sequence
